Our new notification system offers text and email alerts to residents on a variety of topics.



Sign up for traffic alerts, get notifications about special events happening in Oswego, and even subscribe to our Village Board agendas. You can choose how you want your notifications delivered (by text or email) and only sign up for the information you want.

- Decide if you want texts or emails
- Pick your topics. (Want both? Sign up twice, then pick which topics you want sent straight to your phone, and which you want sent to your inbox.)
