OPD Drone Class

Several members of the Oswego Police Department recently participated in a drone class. Officers who attended the class will now be required to take their pilot's licensing test through the FAA. The department currently has 2 drones ready for deployment if needed. Drones can cover territory much more quickly and efficiently than officers can on foot or even by vehicle. An aerial perspective can also provide vital information in search and rescue situations.

2020 General Election

Election Day is quickly approaching! If you are not currently a registered voter, you can still register in person on election day.

Early Voting - Illinois voters can vote before Election Day. The early voting period runs from Thursday, September 24, 2020 - Monday, November 2, 2020. Hours may vary based on where you live. Click [here](#) to find early voting/grace period registration locations.

Vote on Election Day - Voters registered in Illinois can look up where to vote on [Illinois's site](#).

What to bring -

- If you have voted in Illinois before, you don't need to provide ID to vote.
- If you're a first-time voter who registered by mail, and didn't provide your driver's license number, state ID number, last 4 digits of your Social Security number, or a copy of a current ID or government document that shows your name and address when you registered, you'll need to provide one of these when you vote. You can use a copy of a current and valid photo identification, a copy of a lease or contract for residence, student ID & mail addressed to your residence, or a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or other government document that shows your name and address.
- Voters without ID: If you are unable to provide ID, you will be able to vote a provisional ballot. After voting provisionally, you will be told how to submit additional proof of registration to the election authority. The additional information must be received by the election authority no later than the close of business on the Tuesday following the election.
